COVID-19 DAY CAMP PROTOCOLS

Protégé Dance Company is a proud member of "DANCE SAFE ONTARIO" and will adhere to government guidelines and protocols to ensure the health and safety of all our campers, staff and families.



We will practice social distancing, wear face masks, disinfect barres, floors, camp equipment and any other surfaces areas the campers might touch throughout the day. We will use a government-approved disinfectant, Vital Oxide, in our facility to ensure that all participants involved in our day camp are safe. In addition, we will use an industrial fogger (with the government-approved solution: Vital Oxide) to disinfect the room twice a day.

Face Mask Protocol (CAMP)

All COVID-19 Safety Guidelines in effect for: Day Camps as outlined by Ontario Ministry of Health, including the following mask protocol:

- All camp participants in grades 1 (as of September 1st, 2021) and above are required to wear wellfitting masks (e.g., non-medical) while indoors.
- Use of masks is not required for outdoor camp activities if physical distancing of 2 metres can be maintained between camp participants and cohorts are maintained.

What to expect this July 2021 during Ontario's Re-Opening Plan - Step 2:

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP (CAMP)

- We will mandate that all campers be dropped-off and picked-up only.
- Campers will be required to wait outside Unit 8/9 with a face mask, until staff opens the door for entry.
- Students will be escorted into the premises by a Protégé Dance Company staff member and must enter with a face mask on.

FACILITY (CAMP)

- Protégé Dance Company will use one (1) entrance for our Summer Day Camp.
- Unit 8 Door Entrance (Studio "C" Side Door- directly facing Monarch Avenue).
- Protégé Dance Company will use one (1) studio (Studio "C") for our Summer Day Camp.
- Anyone entering and exiting Protégé Dance Company premises will be required to use hand sanitizer (it will be provided), with each entrance/exit into the facility.
- We have created social-distancing boxes: 6' x 6' boxes with 2' space in between to comply with social-distancing regulations.
- Campers are to label all personal belongings to avoid sharing of personal items.
- Campers will perform hand hygiene before and after using shared items/equipment.
- Campers will perform hand hygiene before and after snack/meal breaks.
- Shared items/equipment are cleaned and disinfected after each use.

COVID-19 DAY CAMP PROTOCOLS

SELF-SCREENING (CAMP)

- All parent/guardians must sign/agree to a COVID-19 waiver/release form.
- If a child or anyone in the household is unwell, the child is not permitted to attend camp.
- Each camper, staff and essential visitor has been self-screened for symptoms and relevant exposures to COVID-19 prior to entering camp facilities and/or participating in daily camp activities using relevant screening tool.
- Any camper, staff or essential visitor who screens positive for symptoms and/or relevant exposures to COVID-19 is denied entry to camp facilities (or if needed arrival at camp, is immediately directed to the isolation area while plans made to safely leave).

COMMON AREAS (CAMP)

- Anyone entering **Protégé Dance Company** must wear a mask.
- Anyone entering and exiting **Protégé Dance Company** premises will be required to use hand sanitizer (it will be provided).
- There will be no idling in the common areas.
- Kitchen/Change-room area presently closed.

OFFICE

- At this time, Miss Lori (Administrator) will be taking appointments only.

Safety begins at home:

We need to emphasize the importance of keeping everyone safe at the studio. Remember, safety begins at home, so if your child(ren) show COVID-19 symptoms PLEASE KEEP THEM HOME FROM CAMP and isolate them at home until their symptoms are gone.

Symptoms include: fever, cough, shortness of breath, decrease or loss of smell or taste, sore throat, stuffy/runny nose, headache, nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, fatigue and lethargy. In the case of the first four symptoms listed above, you are urged to contact a health care provider for further advice.
